Atalian Servest Limited confirms that it will exceed the government target of achieving Carbon Net Zero emissions by 2050.

Atalian Servest is committed to achieving Carbon Net Zero emissions by 2030.

Baseline year

Atalian Servest Limited has been measuring its carbon footprint since 2014. However, in 2020, Scope 3 emissions have been included for the first time. As a result, FY 2020 (January 1st 2020 to December 31st 2020) will become the baseline year.

In future years, Atalian Servest will report progress against the baseline emissions year (2020).

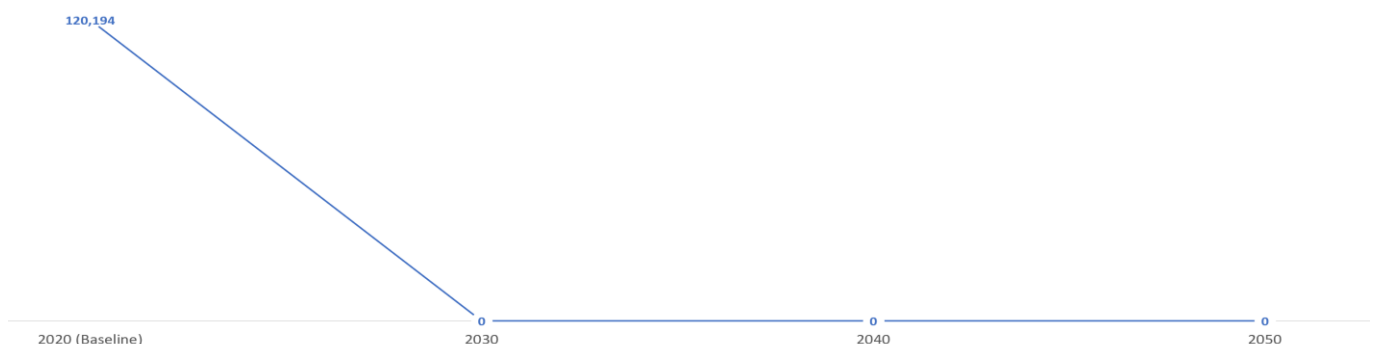


This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 06/21 and associated guidance and reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans.
